
1. Choose **PostgreSQL 9.5.14** and **Windows x86-64** and click **Download Now**. Install the downloaded




2. Install the downloaded file




3. Choose a password. In my code, I chose django1234.




4. Keep the default port of 5432.




5. Uncheck the Stack Builder option and click **Finish**.




6. In your Windows search bar, search for pgadmin and launch it.
